The event held was a Model United Nations (MUN) conference which simulates UN conferences, where each student delegates role-plays and represents a country. Engaging in diplomatic discussions and debates on global issues, participants work collaboratively to draft resolutions.

RVITMUN 2023 featured two committees: the UN Security Council (UNSC) and the Sokovian Accords Implementation Council (SAIC). Delegates, assuming roles of different countries, engaged in diplomatic discussions on global security and the practical implementation of Sokovian Accords in the Marvel Cinematic Universe. This dual-committee setup offered a diverse platform for addressing international and fictional diplomatic challenges.

STRUCTURE:

UNSC :

The UNSC committee in this two-day MUN conference was organised into four sessions, each designed to address specific aspects of global security.

Day 1 :

Session 1 - Opening Ceremony and Agenda Setting (Morning):

Welcome and introductions.

Overview of committee rules and procedures.

Presentation of the agenda items.

Delegates express country priorities during the Speaker's list motion.

Session 2 (afternoon) - Topic Discussion and Moderated Caucus, Unmoderated Caucus to Form Blocs.

In-depth discussions on the first agenda item.

Moderated caucus for focused debates.

More unmoderated caucus to discuss the working paper.

Day 2 :

Session 3 (Morning day 2) -

Moderated caucus on serious issues and finding solutions to the problems, countries defining their stances. Unmoderated caucus for informal discussions and collaboration.

Session 4 (day 2 afternoon) - Working Papers and Unmoderated Caucus :

Delegates collaborate on working papers.

Refinement of draft resolutions.

Final debate on draft resolution.

SAIC :

In this two-day MUN conference, the SAIC committee will have five sessions, each focusing on different aspects of Sokovian Accords implementation. Here's a basic structure description:

Day 1:

Session 1 - Opening Ceremony and Agenda Setting (Morning):

Greetings and introductions, committee rules overview, agenda presentation, delegates share perspectives on current actions and implementations.

Session 2 - Topic Discussion and Moderated Caucus (Afternoon):

In-depth discussions on the first agenda item. Moderated caucus for focused debates. Initial draft resolutions and proposals may be introduced.

Session 3 - Introduction of Working Papers and Unmoderated Caucus (Evening):

Delegates craft positions, unmoderated caucus to set priorities, introduce amendments, and ratify accords.

Day 2 :

Session 4 - Resolutions and Amendments (Morning): Delegates collaborate on multiple working papers. Unmoderated caucus for implementation of final resolutions

Session 5 - Resolution Debate and Closing Ceremony (Afternoon): Final debate on draft resolutions. Voting on resolutions. Closing ceremony, acknowledgments, and distribution of certificates
